The Ngara District Council located in Kagera Region, has received fund from Regional Rusumo Falls Hydroelectric Power Project / WORLD BANK through NELSAP toward the cost of the implementation of Local Area Development Program (LADP) projects and intend to apply part of the proceeds for purchase of modern beehives and equipments for beekeeping projects.

2. Ngara District Council now invites quotes from eligible local suppliers to supply modern beehives and equipments with the following specifications:
